

EXCURSION TO KRAPINA

Krapina is known as one of the most important paleontological sites in Europe, where the remains of Neanderthals were discovered, making this small town an essential destination for all lovers of history and natural sciences.

After departure from the agreed meeting point, the group will enjoy a comfortable drive to Krapina accompanied by a licensed tour guide. Upon arrival, a visit to the Neanderthal Museum is organized — one of the most modern museums in the region. Guests will have the opportunity to learn about the history, way of life, and scientific discoveries related to the prehistoric people who once inhabited this area.

The Krapina Neanderthal Museum is one of the most significant museums dedicated to prehistoric human history in Europe. Located in the immediate vicinity of the Krapina Neanderthal excavation site, the museum provides a detailed insight into the life, customs, and environment of these ancient people who lived more than 100,000 years ago. The exhibitions are modern and interactive, offering visitors a unique learning experience through visual displays, reconstructions, and multimedia content. Of particular interest is the collection of fossil remains found at the site — one of the largest and most important of its kind in the world. Through English-language audio guides, visitors can learn details about archaeological excavations, technology, and the Neanderthals' way of life.

The museum tour begins with a 15-minute introductory film, followed by a guided tour of the permanent exhibition. After the visit, guests can stop by the souvenir shop to purchase keepsakes and publications. The museum exit leads directly to the walking path toward the Hušnjakovo archaeological site. After a short period of free time, the group will return to the departure location.
