

EXCURSION TO THE CROATIAN HOUSE – ETHNO EXPERIENCE OF ZAGREB

Date: 15th July 2026

Beginning: 2:00 PM

*If the first group fills up, the second group enters at 4:00 PM.

Duration: 2 hours

This unique excursion offers an authentic experience of Croatian tradition and culture through an interactive program in the ethnographically designed Croatian House, divided into four ethnological regions: Adriatic, Dinaric, Alpine, and Pannonian.

The program consists of two parts:

1. Folklore Show and Dance Workshop

In the first part of the program, lasting 1 hour, participants enjoy a dynamic folklore performance and take part in learning two traditional dances and one popular folk game. Symbolic prizes are awarded to the best performers, adding extra fun and a competitive spirit.

2. Traditional Souvenir Workshop

Following the dance session is a creative workshop, also lasting 1 hour, during which each participant creates their own souvenir – either a licitar heart or a wooden horse, both protected as part of UNESCO's intangible cultural heritage. Souvenirs are made according to individual creativity and skill and serve as a lasting memento of this special day.

During the program, participants are offered refreshing drinks: a small glass of rakija (cherry or honey brandy), water, and a glass of apple juice, as well as traditional dry cookies and mađarica.

At the end of both parts, a short guided tour of the Croatian House is organized, where participants can learn about the characteristic elements of the four ethnological regions.
